#### Policy

- 1. The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act serves individuals with barriers to employment.
- 2. All client files must include documentation that clearly demonstrates that the client meets the barrier definitions as stated in the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act.
- 3. All potential barriers should be explored, identified and documented to establish at-risk clients with multiple barriers.
- 4. This includes documentation of barriers requiring additional assistance to complete an educational program or secure and hold employment.
- 5. Barrier documentation should also serve as acceptable documentation for data validation.
- 6. Self-Attestation is allowable where stated within the acceptable documentation.
- 7. In the case where a barrier is not provided above, hard copy verification and/or self-attestation is required.
